Outcomes



1. Personality assessment to direct individual career choice
2. Communication skills development

All program enrolled youth will have access to and/or receive the following services based on need: an individual assessment to focus service delivery, establishment of individual goals and benchmarks, program activity engagement (participation in Achieve 365 events and functions), access to employment connection opportunities, assistance with post-secondary transition (college and technical school applications, financial aid and scholarship searches), after-school homework assistance, referral to other support services, as well as follow-up and progress monitoring.
